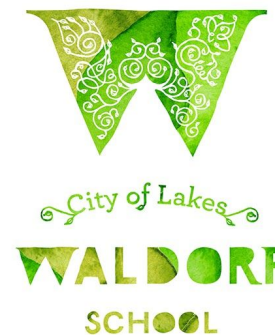

SIBLING DISCOUNT

Tuition is reduced by 10% for the first sibling, 25% for the second sibling and 40% for the third sibling. Sibling discount does not apply to the Toddler/Nursery Childcare Programs, Before Care or Extended Day costs.

TUITION DEPOSIT

CLWS requires an annual non-refundable tuition deposit of \$500 per student; \$150 per student for families applying for tuition assistance. A student's place in the class is not reserved for the following school year until the tuition deposit has been paid and the tuition contract outlining a payment schedule is signed. The tuition deposit is applied in full toward tuition.

TUITION PAYMENT OPTIONS & FEES

One Payment - Due in July, 2021. Payments are made to Tuition Aid Data Services (TADS).

Two Payments - Due in July, 2021 and January, 2022. This plan includes a finance charge of 1.5%. Payments are made to Tuition Aid Data Services (TADS).

Ten Payments - Due each month from July through April. This plan includes a finance charge of 3%. Payments are made to TADS.

Tuition Guarantee - Families who choose the 2 or 10 payment plan are required to pay a tuition guarantee fee. The fee is 2.5% of tuition per student and is optional under the one-payment plan.

TUITION ASSISTANCE

Tuition assistance is available for eligible students in grades K-8. Families access the tuition assistance application at www.TADS.com. Tuition Aid Data Services (TADS) manages enrollment and tuition assistance applications for the school. New families may apply for tuition assistance *after* applying for admission to the school. Tuition Assistance applications for the following school year are due for both new and returning students by February 19, 2021.

ADDITIONAL FEES AND COSTS

Ensemble Program/Instrument Rental and Private Lessons (required)

Students in grades 3-8 participate in our string ensemble program. Parents are responsible for renting or purchasing an instrument and obtaining weekly private music lessons for their child to support class instruction. A limited number of instruments are available for subsidized rental rates from the school.

TRANSPORTATION

Minneapolis Public Schools provides limited bus transportation to Minneapolis residents living in Zone 3 as required by state law. Families outside of Minneapolis and St. Paul may be eligible for transportation reimbursement from their school district.

VOLUNTARY SUPPORT

Each year parents and friends of the school are asked to make an annual gift. Tuition covers significantly less than the actual cost per student incurred by the school. Our school can operate on this basis only because of funds received from voluntary contributions solicited through our Annual Giving Campaign. Gifts are tax deductible.
